Vineyards

The Syrah for our Elizabeth Rose Rosé comes from a 450-acre vineyard in Yountville, Napa Valley named Block House. Block House is the largest of our vineyards and is planted to several different grape varietals. All 100% Certified Organic grapes. The Grenache and Cinsault comes from one of our Oakville vineyards. Those two varietals are planted specifically to make this Rhone-style Rose from Napa Valley.

Tasting Notes

This stylish rosé is elegant and lively with a watermelon hue to the color. On the nose; aromas of rhubarb and strawberry jump out of the glass. On palate, this medium-bodied wine exhibits notes of candied cherry and raspberry. A bone dry Rosé while being extremely fruit-forward with a mouthwatering and crisp finish.

This rosé is a food friendly wine, as well as, a stand alone summer refresher.
